The pediatric emergencies lecture accounts for a mere fraction of your EMT training program...on top of that, you still have to stress over your National Registry test afterwards! It's no wonder why this topic is hardly stressed in class and is merely overlooked by students!

This course will serve as a great review of pediatric assessment & care for any EMT provider (and Emergency Medical Responder)...and I'm sure you'll learn something new, too! One of the strongest skills that an EMS provider can possess is the ability to assess their patient. This course will focus on the various assessment models & methods for pediatric patients, as well as EMT/AEMT pharmacology, and IV therapy. Additional topics also include respiratory distress & airway management, trauma & shock management, pediatric resuscitation, and a brief overview of neonatal resuscitation.

### **age-appropriate response**

Kids can tell us a lot about their overall status merely through how they act and how they appear. This course will break-down various age groups to discuss & compare their communications & responses, vital signs, will show where the ABCs come into play. Although this course is designed for EMTs & AEMTs, it can also be adapted for Emergency Medical Responder (EMR)/First Responder participants.

*A great follow-up course is our Neonatal Resuscitation & Care course (1 hour), which is designed for all EMS providers and can be customized to meet the provider level of the participants.*
